PM IS&A Changes from Jan 2021

- Kickoff sessions for the TITAN Phase 1 OTA were held with the Government team and both vendors the last week of January. The key dates for Phase I activities are being finalized with both vendors. The first key milestone (SRR) and first soldier touchpoint are scheduled for early March.
- The Intel Apps Team reviewed and analyzed responses to the four RFIs (All Source, Intel Support to Targeting, Collection Management, and Weather Effects).


